

# RECYCLE DICE

A quick-to-learn dice game featuring the garden cycle.

## SETUP

Each player needs the following:

- 1 game board
- 9 or 10 tokens (coins, chips, etc.)

The game also requires two six-sided dice (cubes).

There should be a central spot (the “pot”) within reach of all players. This is called the “Recycle Bin.”

## HOW TO PLAY

This game is based on the old dice game “*King & Neighbor*.” Each player takes their turn by rolling the two dice and seeing the result. **The game boards also have results listed on them** in various places on the board.

The object of the game is to be the first and only player with a token on each of the eight spaces in the Garden Cycle. The eight spots are:

• COMPOST (#1)	• GARDEN BEDS (#2)
• SEEDS (#3)	• WATER (#4)
• SPROUTS (#5)	• MATURE PLANTS (#6)
• HARVEST (#7)	• END OF THE SEASON (#8)

- **If a player rolls DOUBLE TWO THROUGH FIVE (2-2, 3-3, 4-4, 5-5),** they must pass a token from their supply to the neighbor on their left. Then they pass the dice to the player on their left.
- **If a player rolls DOUBLE SIX (6-6),** then each opponent gives a token to the player. The player may continue to roll.
- **If a player rolls a result that adds up to 7,** they add a token to the Recycle Bin (the pot). The player passes the dice to the player on their left.
- **If a player rolls DOUBLE ONE (1-1),** they take a token from the Recycle Bin if there’s one available.
- **If a player rolls a result that’s not DOUBLES and not 7,** they add a token to the number’s spot on their game board. The player may continue to roll.
- If there’s already a token on the spot of their Garden Cycle, the player may move that spot’s token (not a new one) to any other empty spot on their game board. Again, the player may continue to roll.

If a player places a token on all the spots in the Garden Cycle, each other player has one more chance to finish their own Garden Cycle. Otherwise the first player to do so wins the game!

- Print out the attached graphic to make more game boards. Laminate them for longevity and plenty of games!
- Color the game boards to add variety and excitement to the scene!
